Membership

Is open to all.

Annual British Gymnastics membership and insurance is required for all gymnasts and trampolinists from parent and toddler classes through to adult classes.

Renewal of membership is due by 1st October and is non refundable.

Fees

Fees are paid in advance for each 12 week term and are non refundable or transferable. You will be charged a 10% surcharge for late payment of fees after the 3rd week of every term.

In the event of a serious long term illness your fees may be credited to the next term.

There are 4 terms per year

October - January / February - May / May - July / July - September.

There is a complete calendar of terms in reception.

Please inform us if your child no longer requires their place. After 2 weeks uninformed absence their place will be taken by the next person on the waiting list

Each term you will receive a bill for your termly fee, this also includes an optional £1 donation which can be gift aided if possible, and used towards the purchase of new equipment.

There are various tiers of family reductions.

Gymnasts

Suitable **Clothing** must be worn. No metal buttons / zips or jeans.

Hair must be tied back.

No Jewellery or body piercings, including earrings.

No food, drinks or shoes are allowed inside the gym.

Gymnasts must not enter the gym until told to by the warm - up coach.

Gymnasts must not use any apparatus unless a coach is present.

Discipline and safety must be observed at all times.

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Parking

There are limited spaces in the Club's car park, there are spaces 100m along the road and **after 6pm** we are allowed to use the Doctor's car park across the road. This is **NOT** available on Saturdays. We request that you adhere to the strict rule that we may not use this generous facility during week days before 6 pm. The **Yellow hatched area** and the designated **foot path MUST NOT** be used to leave parked cars.

Parents

Children under 8 **MUST** be collected from inside the building at all times, and we would prefer that all gymnasts/trampolinists are collected from within the building.

Please ensure your child is on time for their warm-up, as this is an essential part of their lesson.

Please fill out a new membership form if your child's contact details change.

Parental viewing is from the reception window only, do not give gymnast's instructions during the session it will confuse them and place them in danger.

Please do not block the doorways into the gym as these are emergency exits.

No Smoking on these premises.

Please **dispose** of butts in the **bin** and not thrown on the ground.

Please read fire notices on display in the waiting area.

The Club is a non-profit making organisation and has a member's committee.

The Club is affiliated to British Gymnastics and adheres to and agrees with all its rules, and policies on equal opportunities, ethics and child protection.
